



RN TO BSN OPTION FOR REGISTERED NURSES

This Bachelor of Science degree in nursing is available at the Universities of Maryland, Shady Grove Center. Students can complete their nursing studies at Montgomery College and are awarded the AA degree in nursing. RN completion students can complete the required courses for the BSN in one year of full time study. Part time options and online courses make it easy for the RN student to continue their nursing career while taking courses for the baccalaureate degree in nursing. A RN to MS completion track is available to qualified nurses interested in graduate studies.
